Stadium. Parade will start promptly at 10a.m. The parade route will be as follows: Ohio street
too Second St. left onto Green St. then right onto Front St-proceeding to the Washington

parade watcher and is thrown far enough so children will not be walking into the streets to pick
it up. No person or persons may get off or on a vehicle in motion. No alcoholic beverages
permitted in the parade route

1. Open to all youth who are residents of Washington County or are members of an FFA Chapter, 4-H Club or school program in Washington County.
2. Entry may be made in one or both classes by age division: Classes (different pumpkin must be used for each class)-Largest Pumpkin by weight –Best decorated by scar drawing.

6-10 yrs

11-19 yrs

3. Judging will be held at 8:00 pm on Friday evening in the Home Arts Building
4. Seeds are furnished by Tim Glover. Only the variety of seed distributed can be used in the contest. Contact the Extension Office at 740-376-7431 for the seeds packets.
5. Name of the exhibitor must be scared into each pumpkin entered.
6. All entries must be brought to the fairgrounds between 2:00 pm and 7:00 pm on Friday in the Home Arts Building.
7. Limit one pumpkin per class and a different pumpkin in each open class.
8. Open class entries are the responsibility of the exhibitor.
9. Pumpkins must be carved with exhibitors name and age.
